George Washington




George Washington was the 1st president of the united states. Another name they called him was the commander in chief. George Washington led his troops to convince the king of England to let America be independent. They had a war and America won.

James Madison





James Monroe





John Quincy Adams




John Quinsy Adams was the 6th president. He was the son of john Adams. He liked building Roads, Observatories, and canals. He liked doing equations a lot.


Many people blamed Martin van Buren for it.

William Henry Harrison





Millard Fillmore




Millard Fillmore was the 13th president. He fought to end slavery.

Franklin Pierce




Franklin Pierce was the 14th president. He fought in the Mexican American war.

James Buchanan




James Buchanan was the 15th president. He was the only president that never married or had children.

Chester A. Arthur




Chester A. Arthur was the 21st president. He had a bad kidney disease

Grover Cleveland




Grover Cleveland was the 22nd president. In his first term, he vetoed 141 bills.

Woodrow Wilson




Woodrow Wilson was the 28th president. He was commander in chief in world war one.
